Applications to these courses will be ranked and offers released at the beginning of each month (commencing in May 2025) for students based on their grade point average (GPA). Students **must meet** the following requirements to be considered for an offer.

- English proficiency requirements - IELTS or equivalent test (no more than 2 years old) with an overall score of 7.0 with no band score below 7.0. We do not offer ELICOS packaged offers for these courses.
- a minimum GPA of 5.0/7.
