Designed for successful Year 12 graduates (or other approved qualifications) who narrowly miss direct undergraduate entry, this intensive 16-week program builds your academic readiness through targeted learning and personalised support.

Delivered face-to-face in a supportive learning environment, the program is designed to give you the best possible start to your Monash journey.

# What you'll learn

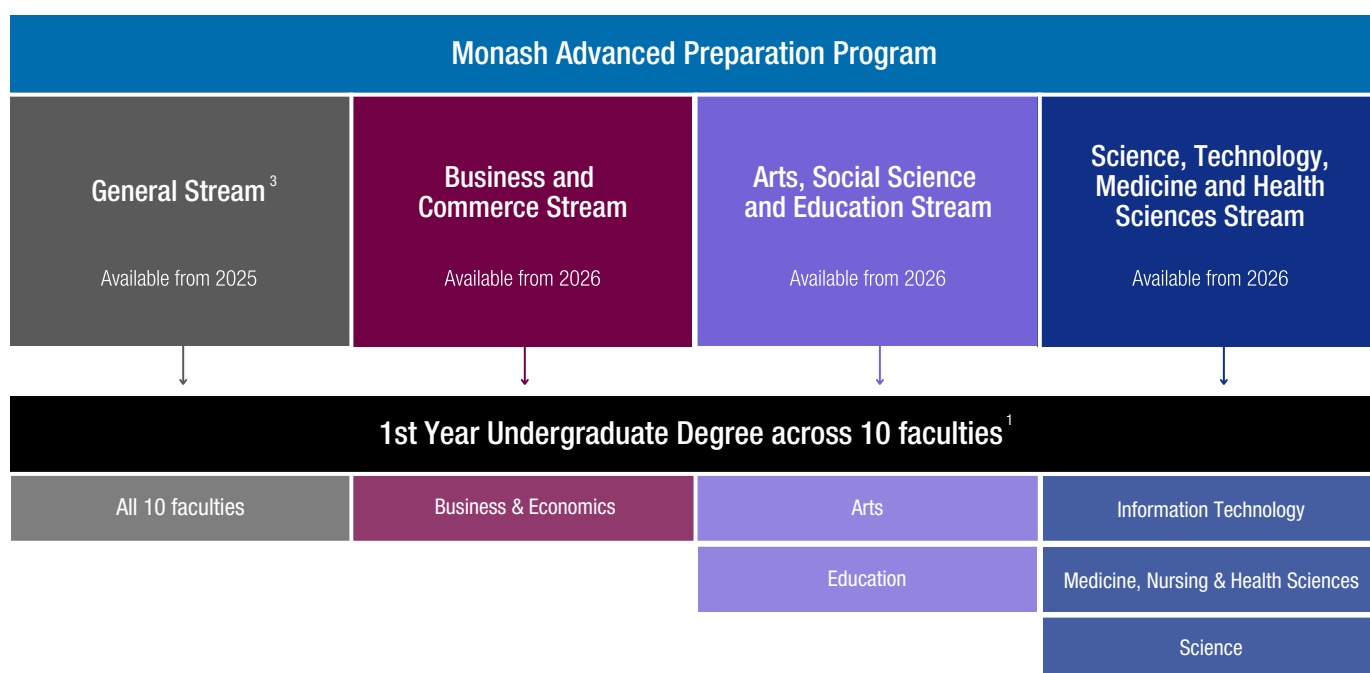
Through the Monash Advanced Preparation Program, you'll deepen your knowledge in key subject areas and develop essential university skills, including how to:

-  One compulsory unit in Introduction to Academic Communication, and
-  Three units aligned with your undergraduate destination degree, selected from your chosen stream.
