- Be a full-time student starting in 2026 or 2027.

Excludes the following programs: Bachelor of Medical Science, Bachelor of Dental Health Science, Doctor of Medicine, Master of Dentistry, Master of Speech Pathology and Graduate Diploma of Flight Management.
