FAQ:

1. Which qualification would QUT use to assess for IMS and RWS?

QUT will use the best acceptable qualification and results from the student's prior studies, including incomplete studies to assess the student's eligibility for IMS and RWS.

2. Will QUT College pathway students eligible for IMS or RWS after completing their pathway program and transitioning into their degree course?

Yes. QUT College students progressing into degrees [from S1 2025 onwards](#) will be considered for IMS or RWS. Students progressing into degrees in 2024 will not be eligible. Eligibility will be assessed at degree-progression stage. The minimum GPA requirement for QUT College progression students will be updated on QUT website later this year.

3. My students have received/accepted a QUT offer without a scholarship, but now I believe they are eligible for the new RSW. Will QUT automatically re-evaluate them for the updated RWS, or do we need to request for a scholarship review?

It is not possible to re-assess all applications that may now be eligible for RWS. Please contact International Admissions [via StudyLink](#) requesting a scholarship review.
