We understand you may still be in your home country, waiting for your visa application to be processed. If you haven't yet applied for your visa, it's important to do so immediately.

If your visa is granted before Orientation (6 November 2025)

If you receive your student visa before Orientation, please make arrangements to attend Orientation and start classes on campus from week one. Orientation and the first two weeks provide essential information on commencing your course, essential campus services, and support systems to help you succeed throughout your studies.

If your visa is granted before the late arrival cut-off date (Friday 21 November 2025) If it's not possible to attend Orientation due to visa approval delays, you must arrive on campus and attend your classes in person no later than the end of Week 2 (Friday 21 November 2025).

If you do receive your visa after the late arrival date (From Friday 21 November 2025 but before 8 December 2025)

If due to visa delays you are unable to arrive by the end of Week 2 (Friday 21 November 2025), you will be eligible to transfer to the Monash English Intensive Program, scheduled to commence on Monday 8 December 2025. You will receive a Welcome email on Monday 24 November 2025 to guide you through the enrolment process.

Unable to arrive before Monday 8 December 2025?

If you do not have a visa in time for the Monash English Intensive Program commencement date of **Monday 8 December 2025**, you will need to defer your studies or apply for an intermission of studies.

What is the Monash English Intensive program?

The **Monash English Intensive program** runs from 8 December 2025 to 6 February 2026 and provides the same curriculum and assessment as the 10-week program. Most importantly, successfully completing the Intensive program will ensure you have sufficient time to enrol in Semester 1 and engage at the Monash University Orientation in February 2026.
