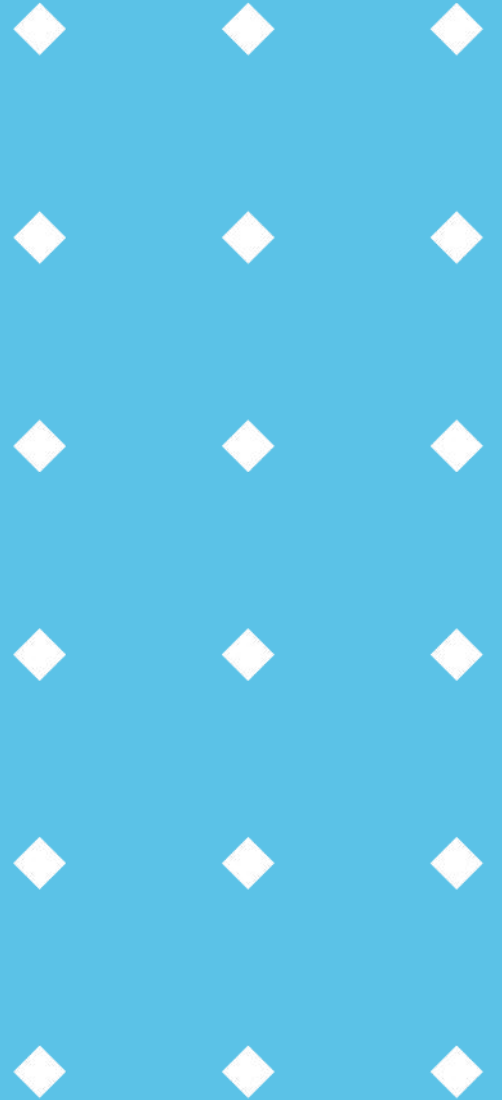

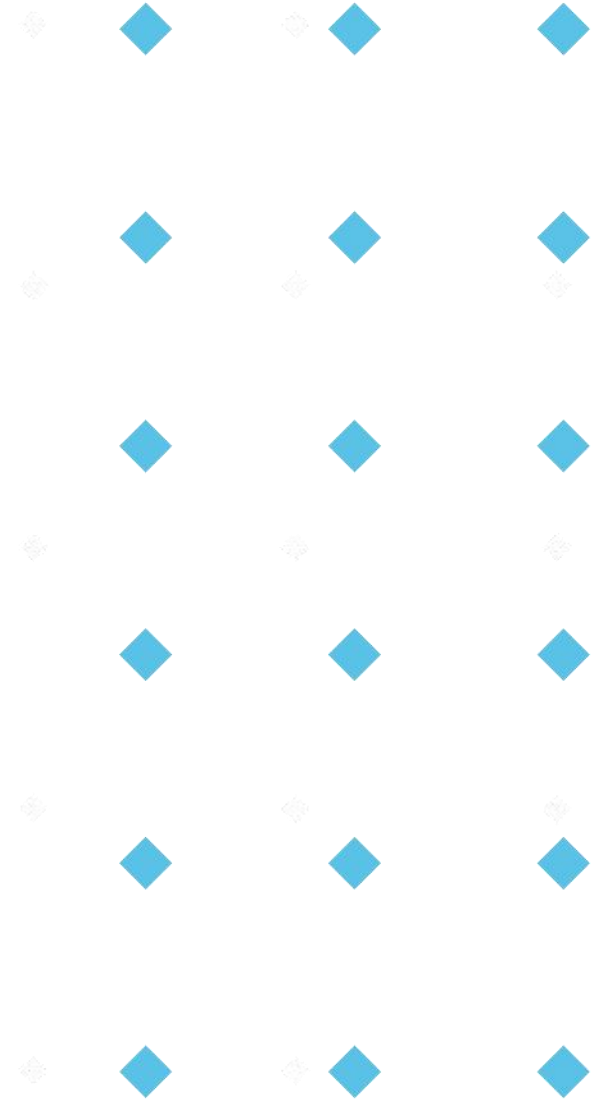

Bachelor of Health Science

- **CRICOS code:** 092156G **Intakes:** Feb, Apr, Jul
- **Campus:** St Albans **Fee per semester:** A\$18,200
- ◆ **Standalone 3-year course**
 - ◆ Complete within 3 years with a combination of majors and minors
- ◆ **Allied Health pathway course**
 - ◆ Transfer* to another allied course
 - ◆ After 6 months
 - ◆ Nursing (HBNB)
 - ◆ Nursing/Midwifery (HBNB)
- ***You will meet the admission requirements, but entry is not guaranteed***



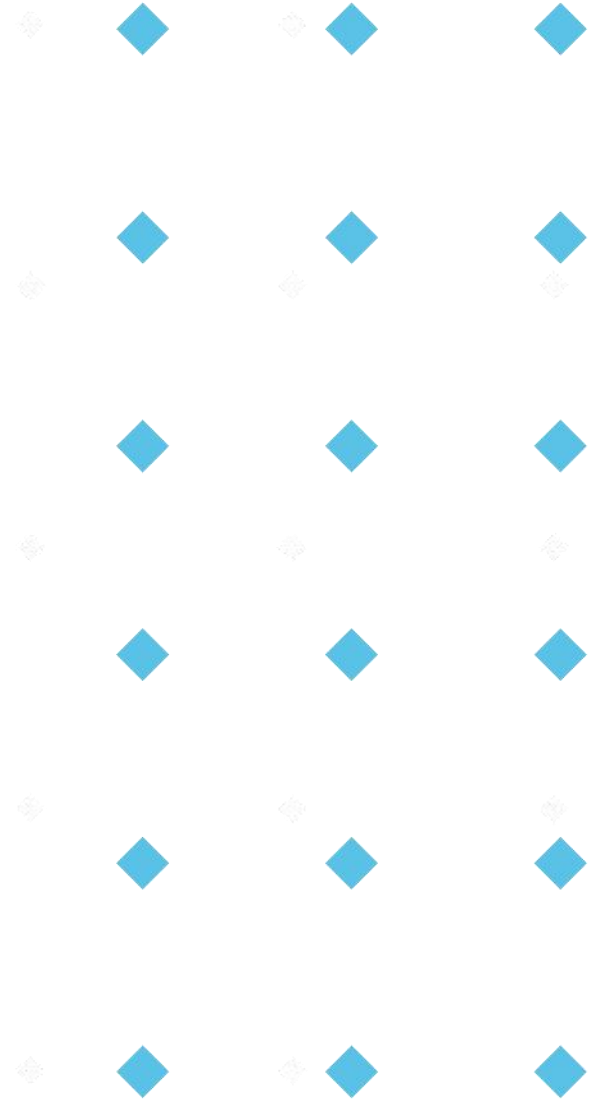
Entry Requirements

◆ Academic Entry Requirement:

- ◆ Completion of an Australian Senior Secondary Certificate (VCE or equivalent) including Units 3 and 4: a study score of at least 25 in English (EAL) or 20 in any other English (or equivalent), **OR**
- ◆ Completion of an Australian Advanced Diploma or Diploma (or equivalent), **OR**
- ◆ Completion of a Foundation course or equivalent

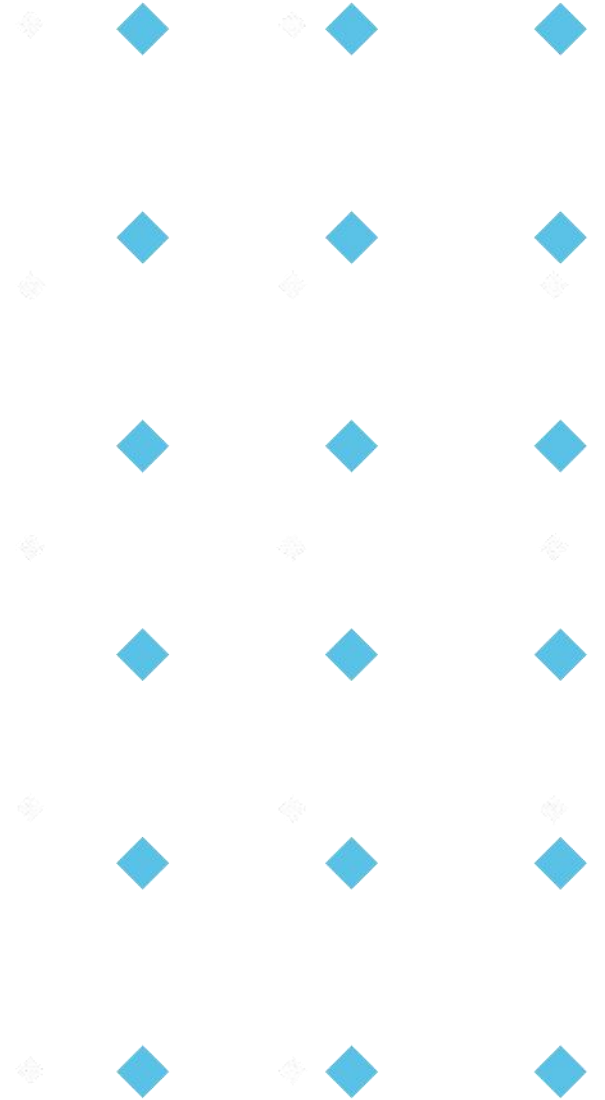
◆ English Requirement:

- ◆ IELTS (or equivalent): 6.0/6.0
- ◆ *Applicants who completed Australian Diplomas within 2 years are deemed to meet English entry requirements*



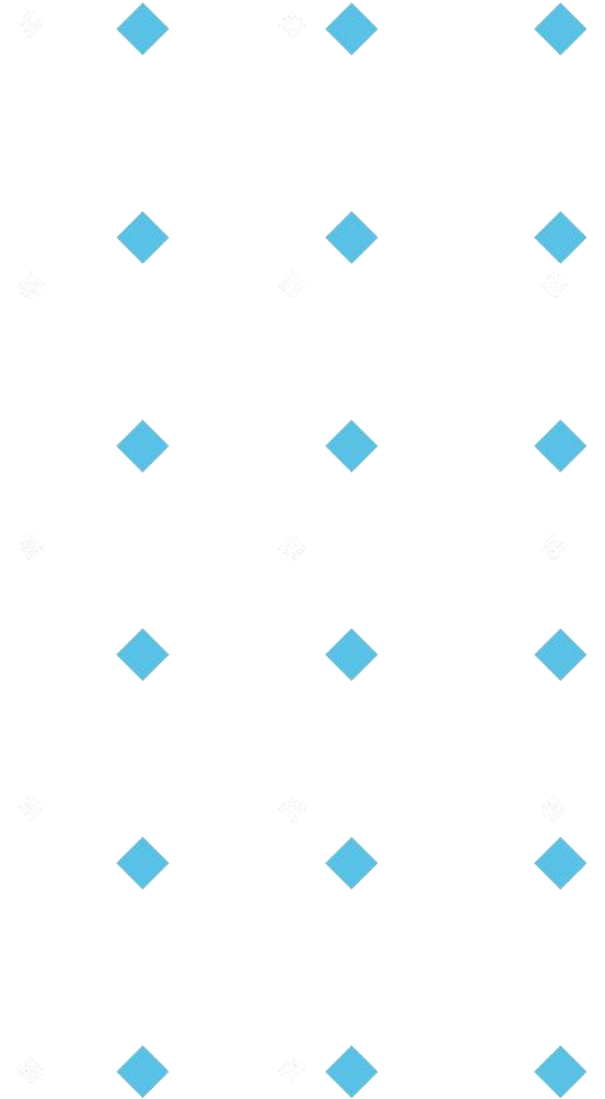
Bachelor of Health Science

- ◆ You need 288 credit points to complete the course
- ◆ Every student does the same first year (96 credit points)
- ◆ Every student does the Public Health Major (96 credit points)
- ◆ **Option A: Indigenous Health Double-Major**
 - ◆ 96 credit points of Indigenous Health Sciences Major (i.e. double major in Public Health and Indigenous Health)
- ◆ **Option B: Two Minors**
 - ◆ 96 credit points that make up two Minors
 - ◆ Indigenous Health
 - ◆ Health (Sport Science)
 - ◆ Health and Nutrition
 - ◆ Bioscience



Points of interest

- ◆ **The first year units are organised so you can transfer mid-year into nursing, or nursing/midwifery without losing credit**
- ◆ **The Health (Sports Science) minor makes you eligible to teach in the Health subject area if you decide to pursue a Master of Teaching (Secondary Education) (EMES)**
- ◆ **Completing the Bachelor of Health Science will give you 4 units (6 months) of credit for the Master of Global Public Health (HMGP)**
