Step 1 - Make sure you have your **Student VISA** granted before enrolling. If you haven't yet, please enrol <u>after</u> you receive your VISA


Step 2 - Create your Monash Account (if you already have an account go directly to Step 2).



Orientation Day

If you are enrolled in your English course and do not attend your class, you will be marked absent and will need to submit an <u>Absence form</u>* with supporting documents **in English.**

Late Enrolment

If you are unable to enrol before the course commencement date, **Monday 24 February 2025**, you must apply for approval to enrol late by emailing latereq@monash.edu.

In your email, include:

- Your first and last name and Monash student ID number.
- An explanation of why you cannot complete your enrolment on time.
- Expected date you will enrol for your English course.

If you are not able to arrive in Melbourne by **Friday 28 February 2025**, you may wish to consider deferring your studies. Please contact scenquiries@monash.edu to discuss your deferment.
