

Onshore Special Admissions Process (OSAP) for Current University of Sydney Undergraduate Students

(Updated 10 Oct 2024)

This information sheet is for applicants who have applied for a postgraduate coursework program at the University of Sydney and intend to participate in the Special Admissions Process. The information contained will assist you with your application and establish eligibility for participation in this process.

Current international students enrolling in their final semester of undergraduate degree at the University of Sydney and seeking to secure a place in a postgraduate degree for the upcoming intake may apply for OSAP.

The Onshore Special Admissions Process allows the admissions team to assess students' eligibility for an unconditional offer based on their penultimate semester results, prior to the release of their final semester results and the completion of their degree.

To be considered, students must:

- Be currently enrolled in the final semester of a University of Sydney undergraduate degree (must not enrol in any intensive subjects that commence after the end of the standard final semester).
- Have an active application for a postgraduate degree in the Semester 1, 2025 intake.
- Complete and sign the Request for Special Admissions Process form, and upload it to the **Applicant's Portal** from the system by 1 November 2024.
- Have an excellent penultimate semester GPA that is at least 2 points higher than the final GPA required for the course applied for. For example, if a course requires a 65% GPA, applicants must have at least a 67% GPA to qualify for OSAP.

Upon meeting these criteria, successful OSAP applicants will receive an unconditional offer with a 14-day acceptance deadline.

Responsibilities of the University

The University of Sydney may withdraw an offer of admission and electronic confirmation of enrolment (eCoE) of any student who fails to meet the entry requirements of their applied course.

By signing the SAP request form, agent (if applicable) and student are confirming the following:

• The application will be reassessed upon completion of studies. If the GPA obtained on completion is below the minimum required for entry into the course, the university reserves the right to cancel the offer and acceptance. Where possible, the university will assist in providing the student with an alternative offer for a course that the student meets the entry requirements.
