University Scholarships: New and refreshed



- A number of new scholarship offerings mostly for offshore students, awarded mainly on merit
- Our scholarship websites are still being updated and further information will be included in the next Agent Newsletter.
- Students are automatically considered for these scholarships.
- Students will receive the offer with the highest value, unless permitted to hold two scholarships
 - **Travel Grants**: for new, commencing offshore students commencing in mid year
 - **Melbourne International Undergraduate Scholarship** – similar to our current MIUS
 - **Melbourne International Graduate Scholarship**
 - **Melbourne International Excellence Scholarship (Graduate)**
 - **Melbourne International Excellence Scholarship (Undergraduate)**
 - **Melbourne International Pathway Scholarships** - for students who have completed a Bachelor degree with Unimelb (alumni or currently completing their Bachelor) and receive an offer for a Masters course (excluding DM, Optometry, Dental Surgery, Physiotherapy & Vet Medicine). Will replace the current Vice Chancellors Pathway Scholarship

FBE & MBS UG Scholarships

Three UG scholarships available from FBE for international students, where all eligible international applicants will be automatically considered:



- **Commerce Undergraduate International Merit Scholarships**: 50% fee remission (up to 300 credit points) for high achieving international students enrolling in BCom, automatically considered
- **Commerce Global Diversity Scholarship**: 50% fee sponsorship (up to 300 credit points) for high achieving international students from eligible countries enrolling in BCom, automatically considered. Ongoing WAM requirements to retain scholarship: Recipients must pass all subjects and achieve a minimum 60 WAM in each half-year study period.
- **AG Whitlam International Undergraduate Scholarship**: living allowance of \$10,000 per year for three years, paid in half-yearly instalments of \$5000 in April and September, for international students enrolling in a Bachelor of Commerce. Ongoing WAM requirements to retain scholarship: Recipients must pass all subjects and achieve a minimum 60 WAM in each half-year study period.



FBE & MBS Graduate Scholarships

Three scholarships available from the Melbourne Business School (MBS) for international students, where all eligible international applicants will be automatically considered:

- **Business and Economics Graduate Pathway Scholarship** – for current Unimelb UG students applying for PG coursework programs at MBS. See information page for more information and selection requirements.
- **Business and Economics Global Diversity Graduate Scholarship** – fee remissions for eligible international students. See information page for more information and selection requirements.
- **Business and Economics Graduate Merit Scholarship** – fee remissions for eligible international students. See information page for more information and selection requirements.

Faculty of Education Scholarships



New scholarship: **Education Dean's Global Excellence Scholarship**

Eligibility:

- International students commencing the **Master of Teaching, Master of Education and Master of TESOL**
- Automatic consideration
- One-off benefit up to \$5,000
- Eligible candidates are ranked based on course entry score

Faculty of Science Scholarships



- Extended the eligibility criteria for the Science Graduate Scholarship (International)
 - Eligibility:
 - not be a citizen of Australia or New Zealand or a permanent resident of Australia
 - have applied for full-time enrolment in an eligible graduate coursework degree
 - not be in receipt of any other tuition fee remission scholarship or sponsorship which, in combination with the Science Graduate Scholarship, exceeds 100 per cent of tuition fees

Scholarship provides a One-off tuition fee remission worth \$10,000.

Selection criteria

- Selected on academic merit.
- Students must achieve an entry score of at least 80% (University of Melbourne equivalent) for all eligible programs except for the Master of Science (Mathematics and Statistics) which requires an entry score of at least 85% (University of Melbourne equivalent)

ABP, FEIT & MSD Scholarship



- New scholarship for automatic consideration: Design Graduate Pathway Scholarship:
 1. Have completed the Bachelor of Design (or its predecessor the Bachelor of Environments) at the University of Melbourne and
 2. Receive an offer to commence a Masters by coursework program in the Faculty of Architecture, Building and Planning.

Scholarship provides a 10 per cent fee sponsorship for an Overseas Fee Place for the duration of the course.
