Conditional CoE Guide for Representatives Start Year 2026 Undergraduate Programs

International undergraduate applicants completing one of the following qualifications and applying for the Start Year 2026 intake may be eligible for an unconditional offer, or a conditional COE, using their predicted/forecast results:

- UK A Level (Cambridge International, AQA, OCR, Pearson/ Edexcel, WJEC, or Eduqas A Levels), or
- Singapore A Level, or
- International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma

Authorised education agents are required to determine if the following eligibility criteria are met.

Unconditional offer using predicted/forecast results

Eligibility

An unconditional course offer and a CoE may be issued to applicants who are completing the UK A Level November 2025 exam, or Singapore A Level May/June 2025 exam, or IB Diploma November 2025 exam, if they meet the following criteria:

- 1. The applicant's school is on the University's list of approved schools for predicted A Level or IB Diploma results. Please refer to page 3 and 4 for the lists.
- 2. The applicant has already met the English language requirements or has the required predicted score in an approved secondary school English subject.
- 3. The applicant's predicted results must:
 - o meet the required grades in prerequisite subjects, and
 - match or exceed the guaranteed entry score for their preferred course if applying with the UK or Singapore A Level, or be at least two points higher if applying with the IB Diploma.

Process

- 1. The authorised education representative uploads the applicant's predicted results (on official school letterhead, signed/stamped) and evidence of English language proficiency to the application portal.
- 2. The University assesses eligibility and issues an unconditional offer if criteria are met.
- 3. The applicant submits the tuition fee deposit and OSHC payment and completes the acceptance agreement in the Acceptance Portal by the indicated offer lapse date.
- 4. Final results must be uploaded to the application portal by the key submission date.

Conditional COE using predicted/forecast results

Eligibility

A conditional course offer and conditional CoE may be issued to applicants who are completing the UK A Level November 2025 exam, or Singapore A Level May/June 2025 exam, or IB Diploma November 2025 exam, if they meet the following criteria.

- 1. The applicant's school is <u>not</u> on the University's list of approved schools for predicted A Level or IB Diploma results. Please refer to page 3 and 4 for the lists.
- 2. The applicant has already met the English language requirements or has the required predicted score in an approved secondary school English subject.
- 3. If applying with the IB Diploma, the applicant's predicted results must:
 - meet the required grades in prerequisite subjects, and
 - be at least three points higher than the guaranteed entry score for their preferred course.
- 4. If applying with the UK A Level:
 - The applicant's predicted results must meet the required grades in prerequisite subjects, and match or exceed the guaranteed entry score for their preferred course, and
 - The applicant must have completed three AS Level subjects that correspond with the predicted A Level subjects and achieved the scores that match or exceed the guaranteed A Level entry score for their preferred course.
- 5. If applying with the Singapore A Level:
 - The applicant's predicted results must meet the required grades in prerequisite subjects, and match or exceed the guaranteed entry score for their preferred course, and
 - The applicant's predicted results must match or exceed the guaranteed entry score for their preferred course.

Process

- The authorised education representative uploads the applicant's predicted results (on
 official school letterhead, signed/stamped) and evidence of English language proficiency to
 the application portal. If applying with predicted UK A Level scores, the official final AS Level
 results must also be provided.
- 2. The University assesses eligibility and issues a conditional COE offer if criteria are met.
- 3. The applicant submits the tuition fee deposit and OSHC payment and completes the acceptance agreement in the Acceptance Portal by the indicated offer lapse date.
- 4. Final results must be uploaded to the application portal by the key submission date.
